ARCOSANTI will host a PRESCOTT JAZZ SOCIETY PRODUCTION for this Second annual celebration of the EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION June 16 and 17, 2001. The festival will include bargain booths including ethnic food varieties, fine art exhibits, health clinics, open forums, and live entertainment that will include gospel, jazz, blues, country, reggae/funk, and new age musical performance.

The 2001 festival's 'Guests of Honor' will be the DARREN BARRETT QUINTET, winner of the 'MONK INSTITUTE OF JAZZ INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION'. Darren Barrett is Berkeley educated and a graduate of the Monk Institute of Jazz Performance at the NEW ENGLAND CONSERVATORY OF MUSIC in Boston, MA. Other festival performers include the HENRY TURNER JR. & FLAVOR Reggae/Funk band of Baton Rouge, La., IMPACT, a 'new age' group performing original compositions, the PATTI WILLIAMS and DELIRIOUS band from the Phoenix area, pianist and recording artist JOE BONNER of Denver, CO, and the MILT CANNON JAZZ BRIGADE with Joe Bonner and Arizona's award winning drummer DAVE COOK.

Former Arizona representative Art Hamilton will kick-off the event at 10:00 a.m. Saturday, July 16. This festival provides fun and entertainment for the entire family.
